Purpose of the 2014 Gulf States Region Caravan Newsletter:

The purpose of the 2014 Gulf States Region Caravan Newsletter is to provide information to all Corvette Clubs and Corvette owners who will be participating in the 2014 NCM National Corvette Caravan.

ALL Corvette Clubs and Corvette Owners are Invited:

- The 2014 Gulf States Region Caravan is open to every Corvette Club and Corvette owner in the Gulf States Region (Southeast Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama and NW Florida Panhandle)
- We welcome ANY Corvette Club or Corvette owner who wishes to caravan with the Gulf States Region.

Gulf States Region Area Caravans traveling to the Gulf States Region Headquarters:

- All Gulf States Region Area Caravans will arrive, at the 2014 Gulf States Region Headquarters, on Monday, August 25.
- You do not have to travel with the area caravans, but it does make the overall experience more exciting.

Area caravans identified to date:

1. Southern Area Caravan (Houston, TX to Birmingham, AL)
 - **Saturday, August 23**, the Southern Area Caravan will leave Houston, TX and travel Interstate-10 to New Orleans, LA where it will stay overnight.
 - The caravan will make stops in Beaumont, Lake Charles, Lafayette and Baton Rouge to allow participants to join the caravan.
 - Overnight in New Orleans, LA
 - Everyone is more than welcome to join the fun in New Orleans.
 - Specific details are being developed

- **Sunday, August 24**, the Southern Area Caravan will resume and follow Interstate-10 to Hwy 231 then turn north to Dothan, AL where it will stay overnight.
 - The caravan will make stops in Slidell, Gulfport and Mobile to allow participants to join the caravan.
 - **Overnight in Dothan, AL**
 - Everyone is more than welcome to join the fun in Dothan.
 - Specific details are being developed
- **Monday, August 25**, the Southern Area Caravan will travel from Dothan, AL to the Gulf States Region Headquarters in Birmingham, AL.

2. **Other area caravans**

- No other area caravans have been identified at this time
- We need area caravans in Northern Louisiana, Central & Northern Mississippi, Northern Alabama and the NW Florida Panhandle.

- Exit into the Kentucky Welcome Center and stage for our arrival at the NCM.
- We will then be escorted to the National Corvette Museum for our arrival parade.

- The 20th National Corvette Museum Anniversary Celebration will be August 28-30, 2014.
- Registration is expected to open sometime in late 2012.
